Answers

1. **GET + noun phrase** - to talk about obtaining and buying things, taking transport and catching illnesses
 - I got my phone
 - I got a surprise
 - the firemen got my name
 - Whenever I get the lift
 - I've got my phone
 - I should get the fire brigade

2. **GET + adverb** - to talk about arriving or the end of a movement
 - could not get there
 - she would get there
 - just got there

3. **GET + object + past participle** - to talk about things that others do for us
 - I decided to get my hair cut

4. **GET + adjective** - to talk about a change of state or to become
 - she got angry
 - had obviously got stuck
 - to get the door open

5. **GET = -ing + adjective** - to talk about gradual development or change
 - I was getting a little nervous
 - was getting very bored

Multi-part Verbs with GET

6. **GET + particle** - to pass an obstacle by climbing it

- able to get over the wall

7. **GET + particle** - to release yourself or someone from a place or situation

- I could not get out
- he was able to get me out

8. **GET + particle** - to move to a higher position

- and get up the stairs

9. **GET + particle** - to enter

- and got into the lift

10. **GET + particle + particle + object** - to re-enter [1]

- they got back into their fire engine

11. **GET + infinitive with 'to'** - to achieve something [1]

- I didn't get to get my hair cut
