Qualification requirements for employment?

A university degree is required, but no TEFL course. Teachers go through a 7-day to 2-week training period before the start of the school-year.

Experience requirements for employment?

Two years of experience is required. Also, that the teacher enjoys children and knows how to control them.

Hire at a distance?

A face-to-face interview is required.

Hire Americans and do their papers?

Working papers are not required before employment and Ashton Campion will assist a teacher in getting their working papers.

All of them.

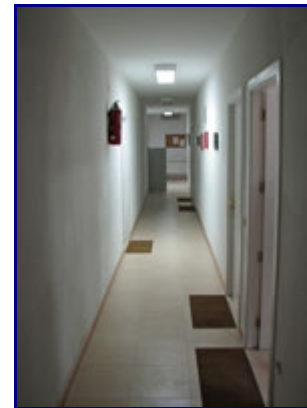
Best part about working at Ashton Campion:
