

## Regular Verbs: The Past Tense.

**A.** Repetition Drill. Pronounce the past tense ending of these verbs as / t / .

1. I helped John last night. (after "p")
2. They liked the play. (after "k")
3. They washed the car. (after "sh")
4. She watched TV last night. (after "ch")
5. He mixed the drinks well. (after "x")
6. We practiced the vocabulary. (after "s" or its sound)
7. She walked home last night.
8. The thief snatched her purse.
9. He worked hard last month.
10. She erased the mistake.
11. He asked several questions.
12. The kids splashed in the pool.

**B.** Repetition Drill. Pronounce the past tense ending of these verbs as / d / .

1. We enjoyed the play. (after vowel)
2. She carried the umbrella. (after vowel sound)
3. We copied the sentence. (after vowel sound)
4. She called last night. (after "l")
5. A fly buzzed past us. (after "z")
6. They used our books. (after "z" sound)
7. She seemed happy. (after "m")
8. She opened the window. (after "n")
9. He answered the question. (after "r")
10. She lived on Elm Street. (after "v")
11. Bonnie robbed banks. (after "b")
